\*\* **AA funding for graduate and PhD students is aimed at** Bildungsausländer (not educated in Germany) from outside the EU who seek to pursue a degree or PhD in Germany.

Any additional income must be offset against the scholarship payment; to determine such ancillary income, the earnings limit for marginal employment as per Section 8 (1) No. 1 SGB IV applies.
